NRL Footy Tipping Competition

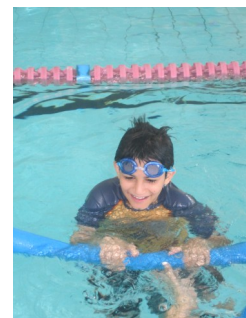
Deb has organised the competition again this year. She has written to all the clubs for prizes and has received a variety of memorabilia to give away at the end of the season.
